REPORT

The gloom of the weekend for Hemel continued with another defeat in the Chess Valley League Div. 1 at the hands of Harefield. On the plus side it was a game with 600 runs scored, 2 centuries, 3 X 50's and scorchingly warm weather. Harefield won the toss and batted first, after the early departure of their opener M Ogden to Guy Scott-Morriss the next two batsmen, R Tidey (155) and D King (104) proceeded to put on 284 runs for the 2nd wicket. That lead the way to a late flurry as Harefield tried to amass as many runs as possible, to the advantage of Jack Doodson who picked up 4-49 by bowling straight. Harefield ended on 326 - 8.

Harefield had a trump up their sleeve in the form of L Tyrell, on Middlesex's books apparently, who whipped out Tom Elborn and Anjam Khan for ducks with some pretty sharp bowling. Luckily Harefield decided to rest him from then, having taken 2 - 3 from 3 overs. The other Hemel opener Glenn Wood saw this happen and was able to make 53 at about a run a ball, better from Hem Ilangaratne 85 from 53 balls with 5 X 4's and 8 X 6's and Jack Doodson with 71, 4 X 4's and 5 X ^'s, short boundary in their somewhere. The chase was always too much for the Hemel lower order, skipper Rory Fraser was able to enjoy himself with an interesting 33* as Hemel ended on 276 - 9.
