REPORT

An epic CVL Div. 2 encounter for a balmy, but breezy, end of June Sunday. A one wicket win for Hemel off the last ball of the game. Hertford won the toss and batted proceeding along at a steady pace. Opener Matt Bartlam hit 53 and no.4 Adam Carlson scored 35 as they moved along to 224 - 9 from their 45 overs. For Hemel Billy May bowled his full 10 overs for 3 - 43 and at the end Lewis Hodgins cleared up for 3 - 40. In reply Hemel were struggling at bit at 84 - 5 but opener Lewis Hodgins was still there. He found an ally in Billy May, who came in at 7. Together they put on 112 for the 6th wicket in very rapid time. Hemel were ahead of the asked for 5 an over run chase. Then disaster as May was bowled for 36 by Hugh Cavener (4 - 33) and Lewis was caught on the road edge boundary going for a big 'un which did not quite get there. As pressure mounted on Hemel what had been 26 runs needed off 10 overs with 3 wickets left boiled down to the last pair at the wicket with 207 on the board. No. 7 Charlie Hoskins (19*) and no. 11 Adam Locke (7*) then became Hemel heroes for the day as they snicked & snurdled runs here and there to get to the last over with 2 needed for victory. Lockie nurdled a single of the first to tie the game, Hosko then fought to get the run off increasingly tight Hertford bowling. Field in for the last ball to prevent the single, he chanced his arm, made contact and the ball pierced the close-in field to disappear for 4 runs and victory.
