

Another winning draw for Hemel I, this time against a side they have not beaten for 4 years in the Herts League. It was all there, batting first and openers Hem Ilangarathe (67) and Lewis Hodgins (147) putting on 158 for the first wicket in 37 overs. Hodgins looked in prime form and the momentum was continued with 42 from Brett Penny at no. 3. 298 - 3 from their 60 overs and Hemel were in the driving seat. Then in the first 20 overs of the reply Flitwick were 86 -5 with all their top 5 batsmen out. That meant shutters up from Flitwick and their no. 6 batsman Dan Nolan duely delivered. He dug in for 84\* from 138 balls and 30 overs to hold up the Hemel train.Bowlers were changed and switched around but all that could be seen was a couple of wickets towards the end.
