**REPORT**

At last a win for Hemel 1sts over at Flitwick , first in 5 years after several draws. And no 50 for Hem who seems to make a habit of scoring 50 against Flitwick over the years, although he was put to shame by a blistering 147 from Lewis Hodgins last year. Winning the toss and putting Flitwick in to bat Hemel managed to keep the Thurstance brothers relatively quiet with nly their first 4 batsmen scoring double figures. Wickets evenly spread between the Hemel bowlers with Brett Penny coming on at the end of the innings to wrap up the tail with 2 - 7 from his 3 overs. Hemel started off brightly in their chase despite the early loss of Ed Langley.Hem llangaratne (27) and Brett Penny (37) put on 62 for the 2nd wicket hitting the first team 50 off 10 overs off 57 balls in just under 40 mins. Then Jack Doodson (33) and Matt Dale (24) put on another 50 runs for the 4th wicket in 64 balls and 1/2 an hour. Almost came a bit unstuck but wicketkeeper Tom elborn was still there with 26\* and skipper Nick Hodgins (10) guided them along to the win until he got out with just one run needed. League game in name, post Covid 45 over run around for remainder of season.
