MINUTES

Apologies: Nic Benson; Tom Elborn; Matt Judd; Robert Lane; Neil Morgan; Dan Turbutt; Aaron Wilson

In the chair: Richard Grayson

- Chairperson's Opening Statement: it was stated that all points would be covered under item 3a.
- 2. Minutes of previous meeting, 23rd July 2019. Proposal to approve the minutes: proposed Nick Hodgins; seconded: Martin Botha. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0.
- 3. To receive and consider:
 - a. The Honorary General Secretary's Report (given by the Chairperson and Club Captain as there is no General Secretary). The report covered the introduction of sub-committees, the use of the Raymond Dean legacy, and developments in cricket.
 - b. The Honorary Treasurer's Report (see attached). Paul Thompson requested that the minutes show that Trevor Radcliffe was thanked by the members for his work.
- 4. Proposal for the award of Honorary Life Membership to Graham Nixon. Proposed: Caradoc Bevan. Seconded: Trevor Radcliffe. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0.
- 5. Constitutional amendments.

RESOLUTION 1

- a. The 27th March 2019 AGM resolved that 'Ordinary members will be co-opted by the Committee rather than elected at the AGM.' This led to the Constitution being amended to state that the AGM would elect Committee members 'With the exception of those defined in Articles 3(f), 3(g) and 3(l)'. It is proposed that in Article 6.1.3 the words '3(f), 3(g) and 3(l)' be amended to read '3(f) and 3(g)' so that the Annual Players Meeting continues to elect the Junior Cricket Manager and Club Captain, but the Ordinary Members are elected at the Annual General Meeting. As a consequence, a change is necessary to Article 4.1.7 so that it is changed from 'Co-opt Members to serve on the Committee as Ordinary Members and/or Sub-Committees' to 'Co-opt Members to serve on Sub-Committees'.
- b. When opening a new bank account this year, the club was told that our address should be more clearly defined in the Constitution. In the opening definitions it is proposed to replace 'on the Heath Park,

- Hemel Hempstead' with 'at Heath Park, Station Road, Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire, HP1 1JZ'. A consequential changes later changes 'the Heath Park' to 'Heath Park'.
- c. A change is proposed to cover the problem of the Committee not having enough members to be quorate and therefore being unable to make decisions, by adding at the end of 5.3: 'If the total number of available Committee members including the President should fall below six a Special General Meeting must be convened by the remaining Committee members.'
- d. A further change to ensure that the AGM elects a Committee that is capable of being quorate is proposed by adding to 6.1.3 after 'Constitution' and before 'to serve' the words ', so that the Committee shall be capable of being quorate'.

Proposed Richard Grayson; seconded: Trevor Radcliffe. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0.

RESOLUTION 2

- a. We do not currently have any defined figure for having a sustainable financial reserve. At end of article 1.1.3 add the following: 'The Club's financial reserve should be between £5,000 and £10,000 at the end of each financial year and it may not fall below £5,000 without specific approval of a General Meeting.'
- b. A further financial control is proposed to add to the end of 4.1.1: 'In addition, the terms of any agreement committing the Club to liabilities (such as lease, rental, or loan) totalling more than £5,000 in any 12 month period shall be submitted for approval to a General Meeting.'

2b was amended at the meeting with the addition of the words 'outside normal trading' prior to 'such as' (Proposed Trevor Radcliffe; seconded: John Birnie. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0) so that it read: 'A further financial control is proposed to add to the end of 4.1.1: 'In addition, the terms of any agreement committing the Club to liabilities (such as lease, rental, or loan) totalling more than £5,000 in any 12 month period shall be submitted for approval to a General Meeting.'

Proposed Richard Grayson; seconded: Trevor Radcliffe. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0.

6. Resolutions 3 and 4.

RESOLUTION 3

The Committee may by resolution spend approximately £20,000 on new net facilities in the area currently commonly known as the 'junior nets' (the nets on the edge of the nursery ground), with £5,000 of this provided from club funds, £5,000 from the 2019 Golf Day, and £10,000 from an England and Wales Cricket Board loan (interest free, repaid quarterly over five years at £500 per quarter), with the aim of the new nets being in place for the start of the 2020 season.

Proposed Richard Grayson; seconded: Trevor Radcliffe. Votes: for 22; against 0; abstained 0.

RESOLUTION 4

The Committee may by resolution approve up to £10,000 to be spent on benches, carpets and chairs in the bar area.

Treasurers Report - AGM 25-09-2019

Six months on and so much has happened since we last met at the AGM and this one is an interim position as far as the accounts are concerned. This is to allow us to change our Year End to 31st March and report back to you during September each year. This is for a few reasons from my point of view. It lines up with the government's reporting periods, allows us to report at the end of a season, and gives the treasurer a sensible period to get the accounts reviewed properly.

The main events since the last AGM are:-

- 1) The bequest has been completed
- We have started to move all the bank accounts from Nat West and RBS to Metro Bank.
- We have upgraded our beers and other products on the bar.
- 4) We have paid off most of our external loans

I am not going to go through the numbers in detail but I will cover a few key areas from the events above.

The bar offerings have allowed us to bring the margins back over the 50% level that we have always targeted. Along with this and the events that we are running has meant that our bar takings are £10k up on last year to date and as of yesterday have exceeded last years complete total at £73k as of yesterday.

This has been done with, I believe, only 4 Saturdays being used during the season. The target for next year is zero events on Saturdays in the season for next year.

A big thank you to Emma and the team for all their hard work in this area. Now all we need to do is get some of Emma's life back – We are working on that one.

The aim by changing the bank is to bring down costs and make it easier to do business. The first will come when we finally close Nat West, RBS has already been closed. The second has already arrived with a greater customer service offering from Metro.

Items 1+4 above go hand-in-hand – The bequest has allowed us to clear all of our external loans with the exception of £500 that the ECB have not taken yet. We now intend on working up a plan to repay the debenture holders who helped build the pavilion.

This has also led to a reduction in interest charges and increase in the cash balances held, a decrease in the trade creditors and a decrease in the amount of invention that I have had to use in the creation of new reasons why they are not being paid. Frankly I had lost count of which lies I had used for which supplier.

I am looking forward to the challenges of planning projects to move the club forward rather than working out how we are going to survive the next winter.
