**REPORT**

Defeat to the Championship leaders who had bowled us out for 79 earlier this season to be expected but the makeshift Hemel 1st XI made a good fist of it. Stortford won the toss and batted first and after 30 overs were only 121 - 5, things looking good for Hemel. But then Ryan Wells (31), Dominic Clutterbuck (44\*) and Matt Pike (34\*) put on another 110 runs in the last 20 overs to push Stortford up to 231 - 6 from their 50 overs. Charlie Hoskins coming on as 7th bowler had the best returns with 3 - 26 from his 10 overs. In their reply Hemel reached the halfway point of 25 overs without losing a wicket with their score at 70 - 0. Then the Stortford bowlers dug in. Ed Langley (33) was the first to go and then the wickets tumbled. Opener Brett Penny (50) was the 4th to go with the score on 104. Jack Doodson managed to add 22 but the rest of the batting went to be all out for 144.

Funnily enough Hemel still remain in 4th place in the Championship 2 points ahead of their final opponents Luton Town & Indians next week. When Hemel played them at Wardown Park at the end of the first half of the fixtures Luton got a winning draw, their first positive result of the season. Since then they have won 5 games of the next 8 so they are a team in form although they lost to as good as relegated Letchworth GC this weekend.
