REPORT

Loss last week at Flitwick followed by a loss this week at home to Preston, hopefully not the start of a sequence like the start with 3 wins followed by 3 defeats. Away at Reed next week to be watched. Early morning rain meant that this game was reduced from a 50 over to a 45 over match. Preston won the toss and batted first. Hemel kept their run scoring well under control until the end when a 9 ball 20 from Pete Murrell pushed Preston over the 200 mark to end up with 212 - 9. Their earlier batting had seen opener Phil Simpson make 58 from 96 balls and no.3 Will Mercer 53 from 95 balls. Billy Jones took 3 - 23 from 8 overs at the top and Parth Mehta (2 - 37) and Brett Penny (2 - 28) took a couple each at the bottom. Not a great start to the reply with Hemel finding themselves at 3 - 2 after 4 overs with both openers back in the pavilion. Lewis Hodgins scored 35 at no.3 to get Hemel back and then Ben Mannering (50) and Billy Jones (54) put on 69 for the 4th wicket to get Hemel to 126 - 4 after 30 overs. The required scoring rate was always rising and no Hemel batsman was able to stay around for long to get to the asking total. Nick Hodgins struck 19 in 15 balls but too many catches went up and were taken together with a couple of stumpings off the Preston skipper Max Anderson. Defeat for Hemel by 22 runs as they slip to 4th in the Championship together with 5 other sides who have won 3 lost 2.
