REPORT

Brett batted through until the last over by which time he had got the score up to 217 - 7. The Hemel opening bowlers Billy Jones (3 - 16) and Matt Parkins (1 - 28) took into the Dunstable top order and after 9 overs had them at 25 - 3. Dunstable attempted to fight back but the spin skill of Parth Mehta (9 - 0 - 18 - 1) kept them always behind the clock and the introduction of Lewis Hodgins took the game firmly away fro them, He returned 4 - 20 from his 10 overs and Dad Nick picked up a wicket until Billy Jones returned to take out the Dunstable no.11 second ball to bowl them out for 135 and an 82 run win for Hemel. With Flitwick beating still 2nd placed Shenley Village to 3 sides after Championship winners Old Owens became a little more condensed. Shenley (295 pts) are away to Reed, Flitwick (288 pts) are home to Preston and Hemel (284 pts) are away to already relegated Luton Town & Indians. A win for Hemel and fingers crossed on other results is the order for next weekends finish.
