REPORT

A young Hemel Sunday side going out to contest the last CVL game of the season and defeat to Harrow. Winning the toss and batting Harrow seemed to be running away with it around Shlok Adurkar scoring 73 until Tayyab Sadiq came on for Hemel and picked up 4 - 44 to put the breaks on. Harrow ended on 249 - 9 from their 45 overs.

Hemel's reply started off badly, slipping to 10 - 2 then 27 - 3 with the first 3 batsmen out. Lutero Corrigan (34) tried to keep things together but wickets kept on falling. A partnership of 41 for the 8th wicket between Jacob Hodgins (25) and Lucas Bertin (30) stabilised things a bit but the end score was 182 - 9 and defeat by 67 runs.
