REPORT

Inability to take out the last wickets proved costly for Hemel again as Dunstable skipper Sam Cherry was able to score 94* from no.5 and put on a match winning 63* partnership for the 8th wicket with no. 9 Harry McBrearty (29*) to snatch the spoils for Dunstable. Hemel won toss and batted putting together 237 - 9 from their 60 overs. Brett Penny kicked off at the top with 57 and Ed Pike scored 52* from no.6. As seems the norm. Parth Mehta is the main bowling hope and he bowled figures of 18 - 1 - 79 - 3 and there were a couple of wickets from Darren James (2 - 27) having Dunstable at 140 - 5 then 178 - 7. But the 8th wicket partnership proved crucial as Dunstable won. Halfway through the league season Hemel are 7th in Championship, Dunstable 6th.
